Formation: Couple facing couple in a large circle. Woman is on man's right.

Steps: Walking step, buzz (waltz position, joined hands palm down).

Pattern:

- I. Small circles of two couples  
1-8 16 walking steps to the left.
- II. Chain  
1-8 Give right hand to partner, left hand to corner, right hand to partner again, and stop in front of corner with three forceful stamps. Four walking steps per hand
- III. Buzz with corner (whole number of times).  
1-8 CW turn.
- IV. Chain  
1-8 Start by giving right hand to corner, and end in front of partner (man goes CCW, woman CW).
- V. Buzz with partner  
1-8 (The two couples have changed places.)

Repeat from the beginning, or do the following variation:

Variation: *Done at Mill Valley most often*  
Form a large circle around the room, woman on man's right.

- I. 16 walking steps to the left.
- II. Chain, give right hand to partner and continuing in circle, man CCW, woman CW, give left hand to number 2, right to number 3 and stop in front of number 4 with 3 forceful stamps. 1 2 3 4
- III. Buzz with number 4.
- IV. Chain, give right hand to number 4 (with whom you just buzzed), then left hand to number 5 and right hand to number 6. Stop in front of number 7.
- V. Buzz with number 7.

To continue, repeat either in the small circles or in the large circle. I suspect that for Nordlek-85 we will alternate patterns. Note that each time the small circles are reformed, the same two men will be together, although they will have different partners.
